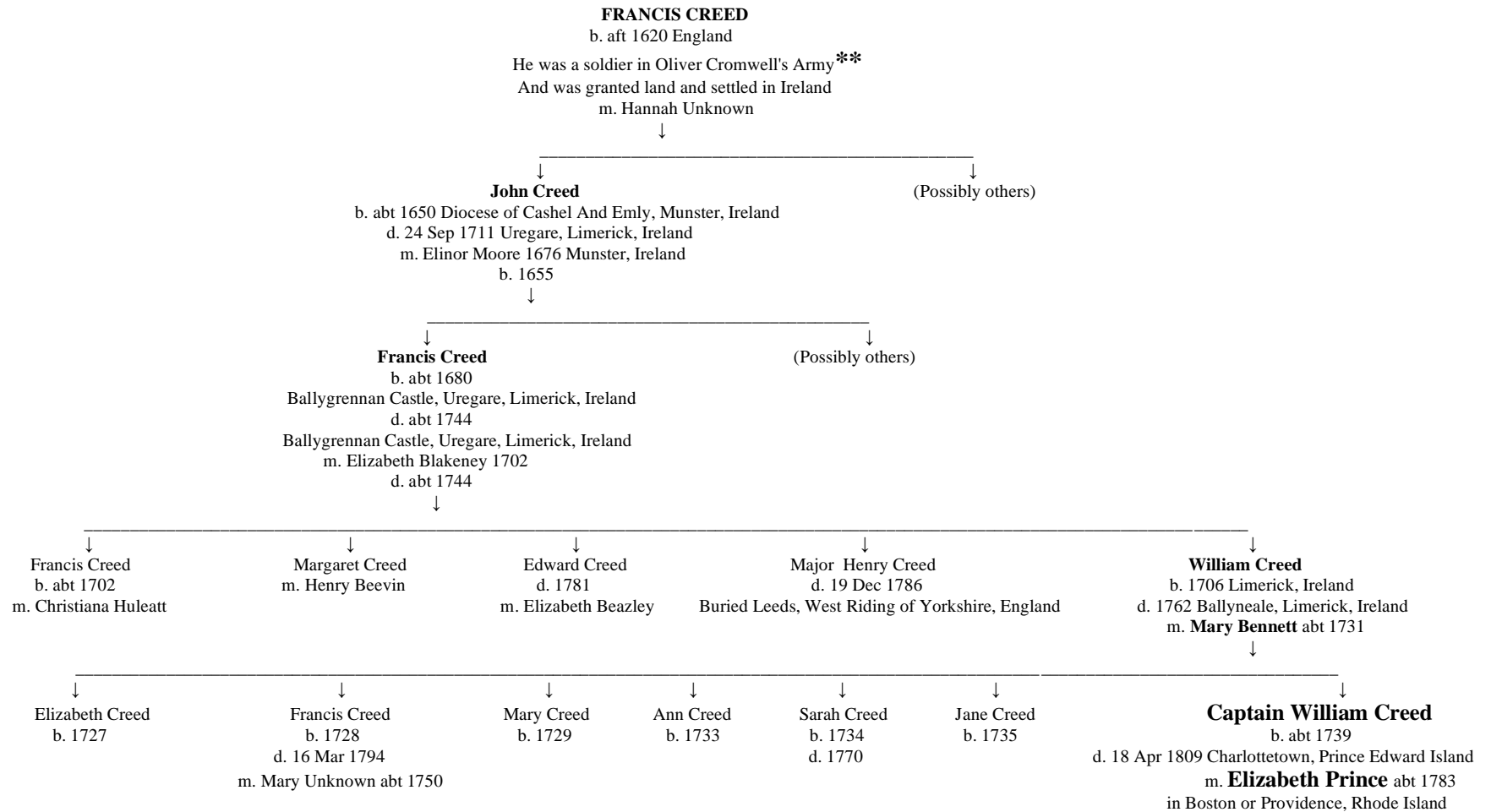


## PATERNAL ANCESTRY LINE OF CAPTAIN WILLIAM CREED

**\*\* Note:** In Louis Cantelo’s narrative, on file with the Prince Edward Island Genealogical Society, he quotes a story told to him by his grandmother that “Stories told are sketchy, but one told about his [Captain Creed's] ancestors, which I think was about his grandfather [actually his great, great grandfather] who was traveling around the country (Ireland) after the days of the Battle of the Boyne [July 1, 1690]. Night came upon him and he took refuge in a house for the night, and he was upstairs in bed when hostile people entered the house and began talking about their enemies. The woman of the house said, ‘Be careful, there's one of them upstairs.’ ‘We’ll soon take care of him,’ they replied. Creed was not asleep, but armed with the proper instruments of his office. He quickly drew his steel and slit the thatched roof and slid out on the ground and was away. As the story is told, if it hadn't been for his quick thinking, there would be no Creeds on Prince Edward Island today.”
