Census Returns For 1861, 1871 and 1881, Surrey, Lot 58, Queens, Prince Edward Island, Canada – Church of Scotland. It is believed, based on the date of birth of both Samuel and Catherine (early 1800's), the fact that they were born in PEI and first lived in Lot 57, that their parents were Selkirk Pioneers. However, no documentation on their parents has been discovered.

Mrs. Neil McLean "In the early morning hours of Wednesday, April 3rd, Mrs. Neil McLean, a very highly esteemed resident of Melville Station passed peacefully away at the ripe old age of 81 years. For several months before the coming of the end the deceased had not been in a very good condition of health. From time to time she complained of feeling very tired and somehow could not seem to get rested. All that medical skill and king friends could do was done but all to no avail. Her whole system seemed to be breaking down at once. Life's machine was apparently all worn out and it was evident that the end was not far away. Although possessed of very rugged constitution her supply of reserve energy was not getting low. She sank gradually until on the above-mentioned date here quiet spirit winged its heavenward flight. ... The deceased was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Samuel McLeod of Surrey and was the last surviving member of a family of four brothers and seven sisters. Mrs. McLean was a woman who was quite widely known and was held in high esteem by all. In whatever pertained to the welfare of the church, the school and the community she always took a deep interest. For many years she was a loyal member of the Presbyterian Church in Canada and her church was always very dear to her. Unless prevented from attending the Sunday services because of some good reason her place in the sanctuary was seldom or never vacant. In the region of her home life, she was wonderfully kind and sympathetic. To her home all worthy comers received a hearty welcome and no none needing aid ever called upon her in vain. In times of sickness and sorrow she was a real mother in Israel. It was ever her great delight to car for the needy, to watch by the sick, and to seek to bring comfort to the said and to the sorrowing ones of life. Hence forth many an ailing brow will miss her healing touch and many heavily laden lives will await in vain the coming of one who was ever ready to share with them the weight of their burdens and their trials. But while many in the outside world will miss her, it is in the old home that her loss will be felt most keenly. There her loved ones will yearn in vain for her kindly presence, her wise counsel, and her words of comfort and of good cheer. Yet knowing that her life has been filled with the things that count most when and believing this she has already received "the well done of the good and the faithful servant" none would be so unkind as to wish her unbound, spirit back into bounds again." The funeral service was very large and was held at her old home on the afternoon Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>... The pall bearers with Messrs.
